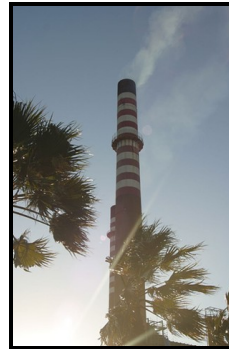
The ESG is an environmental NGO which formed nearly 10 years ago to work locally to address environmental issues.
