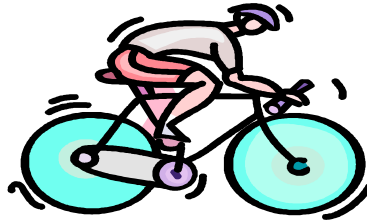


ESG NEWSLETTER "CYCLE RIDE FOR CLEAN ENERGY" 2006
